Cultural experiences in PNG are one of a kind, you'll be one of the few groups that they receive that week, rather than one of many coming through that day. Itineraries are generally finalised in the final few days before the tour is conducted to ensure that cultural experiences do not interfere with tribal life, for example a HausKi (funeral).

Pristine and colourful corals are home to a variety of fish, crustacean and invertebrate life and many of the reefs have resident schools of barracuda, tuna and jacks. A range of shark species are regularly sighted particularly on the offshore reefs. Resident pods of dolphins frequently entertain snorkelers transiting between sites. The occasional sightings of orcas, pilot whales, whale sharks and other marine life passing through Kimbe Bay waters delight both guests and staff.

In Kimbe Bay, you'll likely be the only snorkelling/diving boat out on the water, so there's no fighting for the best spot - just enjoy the secluded and private experience.
